The Center for Gender in Global Context (GenCen) will be awarding one scholarship to students attending each of the Women's & Gender Studies (WGS) Study Abroad Programs in

- *Amsterdam (Sexual Orientation, Gender Identity & Sexual Politics),
- *London (Gender, Sex, and Feminism in the UK), and
- *Malawi (Development and NGOs: Internships)

These scholarships, for \$1,000 - \$1,250 each, have been made possible by generous donations from the 2017 Director's Challenge Campaign.

Students are eligible to apply if they are:

- 1) Rising juniors, juniors, or seniors.
- 2) Enrolled in a Women's & Gender Studies degree program (WGS major/minor or LGBTQ minor).
- 3) Have at least a 3.0 GPA.
- 4) "Have demonstrated the capacity to make a difference in public service upon graduation."

Applications Must Include:

- 1) A cover letter expressing interest in the scholarship, how the study abroad program furthers their scholarly interests, and how they plan to use their women's and gender studies degree after graduation.
- 2) A resume or CV.
- 3) Proof of acceptance to one of the listed WGS Study Abroad programs.
- 4) Preference will be given to students demonstrating financial need; materials in support of demonstrating such need are encouraged as applicable.
