The award is named for Dr. Gallin in honor of her 13 years as director of the Women and International Development Program and her scholarship in the area of women, gender, international development, and globalization.

Paper Requirements:

- 18-22 pages, not including bibliography
- 12-point, Times New Roman, double-spaced
- Completed within the last calendar year prior to submission
- Focus on issues related to women, gender, international development, and globalization
- Submitted in .doc or .docx format (take tear-off strip for link)
- Deadline: 11:59p.m. Friday, November 8, 2019

Papers will be reviewed by a faculty committee, and the award will be presented at the GenCen Annual Reception on January 31, 2020. Winning author(s) will receive a **\$250.00** prize. The winning paper may also be peer-reviewed for publication in the *GPID Papers* and/or on the GenCen website.
