Thank you for agreeing to complete a book review to be published in *GPID*. We are grateful for your important contribution to our journal. Below you will find the necessary information to complete your review. If you have any questions, please contact [papers@msu.edu](mailto:papers@msu.edu).

**Timeline**

We ask that you return a full manuscript within 90 days of receiving the title for review. Once we have received your manuscript, the *GPID* team will request revisions as necessary.

**Topics to include & questions to consider**

- A brief summary of the title provided. What is the main argument?
- Analysis of how the title contributes to or builds upon the existing literature.
- What are the strengths and weaknesses of this title?
- Who would you recommend this title to?
- What is your assessment of this title?

**Length**

Book reviews should be between 1,000-1,500 words. If they do not fit this word count, reviews will be sent back to the author.

**Formatting**

- Use of [Chicago Manual of Style Author-Date](#) referencing format
- Use of U.S. English, with careful review for grammatical and typographical errors
- Clear structure (suggested sections include: intro, summary, contribution to the field, conclusion)
- Includes a list of 5-10 keywords for the book

**Audience**

Please consider the audience of your review. *GPID* is an interdisciplinary journal with a wide readership, therefore, your review needs to be accessible to those outside specific disciplines. Avoid using jargon and technical terms unless you are able to articulate accessible definitions.

**Biography**

Please include a short biography of yourself, including name, pronouns, institutional affiliation and position, and any other relevant information.
