The award is named to honor former women's rights activist and MSU Women's Studies scholar Dr. Mary Anderson, who lost her battle with breast cancer in 1993.

Paper Requirements:

- 15-20 pages, not including bibliography
- 12-point, Times New Roman, double-spaced
- Completed within the last calendar year prior to submission
- Focus on issues related to women and gender in global perspective
- Submitted in .doc or .docx format to [tinyurl](#) link below
- Deadline: 11:59p.m. Friday, November 8, 2019

Papers will be reviewed by a faculty committee, and the award will be presented at the GenCen Annual Reception on January 31, 2020. Winning author(s) will receive a **\$250.00** prize. The winning paper may also be peer-reviewed for publication in the *GPID Papers* and/or on the GenCen website.
