

SEXUAL ORIENTATION, GENDER IDENTITY AND SEXUAL POLITICS IN AMSTERDAM

The Sexual Politics in Amsterdam program provides a deep immersion into the diverse and radical queer cultures that permeate the city's history.

Students take guided tours of iconic locations, including the Red Light District, the Black Archives, and world-famous museums and art venues, while learning directly from LGBTQ+ scholars, activists, and refugees.

On the final weekend of the program, students attend the Canal Pride festival, one of the largest LGBTQ+ celebrations in the world.
