

The Center for Gender in Global Context (GenCen) invites MSU undergraduate students to apply for its annual Tracy Dobson Activism Award competition, named to honor Tracy Dobson's tireless efforts to bring gender equity to MSU. Professor Dobson retired in 2011 from MSU's Department of Fisheries and Wildlife, and her commitment to inform and inspire students to work for social justice led many students to seek careers in public service and to pursue advanced degrees. The award honors an MSU undergraduate who has distinguished themself through exemplary local, national, or international activism on behalf of gender equity and social justice.

Requirements:

- •Three-page paper (.doc or .docx format) describing:
 - *Description of a feminist cause you are committed to
 - *Evidence of that commitment/your role in cause through college career
 - *Dedication to a career in some aspect of gender equity and social justice
- •Resume/CV (PDF Format)
- •Two letters of support from a supervisor, co-worker, peer activist or MSU faculty or staff mentor (PDF format)
- •Deadline: 11:59p.m. Friday, November 8, 2019 to tinyurl link below

Submissions will be reviewed by a faculty committee, and the award will be presented at the GenCen Annual Reception on January 31, 2020. The winner will receive a \$250.00 prize.
