

RCGV PAPER AWARD

Best Undergraduate Paper on Gender Violence

The Research Consortium on Gender-based Violence (RCGV) and Center for Gender in Global Context (GenCen) invite MSU **undergraduate students** to submit a paper for their annual RCGV Paper Award competition.

Gender-based violence includes any form of harm that is both a consequence and cause of gender power inequities. It can be physical, psychological, sexual, economic, or sociocultural, and includes but is not limited to sexual abuse, rape, intimate partner abuse, incest, sexual harassment, stalking, femicide, trafficking, gendered hate crimes and dowry abuse.

Paper Requirements:

- 15-20 pages, not including bibliography
- 12-point, Times New Roman, double-spaced
- Completed within the last calendar year prior to submission
- Focus on any issue related to gender-based violence
- Submitted in .doc or .docx format to the link below

Papers will be reviewed by a faculty/grad student committee, and the award presented at the GenCen Annual Reception. Winning author(s) will receive a **\$250.00 prize**. The winning paper may also be peer-reviewed for publication in the GPID Papers and/or on the GenCen website.

Submissions are to be made via Qualtrics by 11:59p.m. on December 11, 2020.
